INDIA ROBUSTA PARCHMENT AB WHITE FOREST ELK HILL ESTATE

India is a country full of color: bowls of spices in brick-red and ocher shades in vivid market streets, turquoise water hitting golden beaches, and verdant volcanic mountains pervading picturesque flora. The state of Karnataka is shaped by the Western Ghats mountain range. It is home to one of the greatest biodiversity hot-spots in the world.

In the center of India's coffee heart, along the impressive mountains of these Western Ghats, the Elk Hill Estate is located. Consisting of eight different farms in immediate proximity, 927 hectares of planted coffee trees call this area their home. About two thirds of this area account for Robusta coffee as the altitude for fine and nice Robustas is ideal. The coffee trees grow along citrus and pepper plants, while the valleys are covered in rice fields. Natural forests allow for shade-grown coffee with higher flavor intensities through slower ripening of the cherries. The in-house coffee processing facilities cover the whole production chain of coffee and allow for full traceability: after the harvest, the coffee is processed at the own wet and dry mills, then packaged and exported.

The farm has continuously been working towards specialty quality and has won the domestic award "Flavour of India". These beans from Elk Hill come with a delicate and complex flavor – a truly unique and smooth Robusta for your espresso.
