COLOMBIA EXCELSO HUILA

The department of Huila is located in the southern part of Colombia, and it's the geographic knot of the Andes mountain ridge. Here, the three ranges for the Cordillera split between western, central, and eastern Andes, heading towards northern Colombia.

Between the eastern and central cordillera flows the Magdalena River, which goes up to the Caribbean Coast. and between the central and western Andes mountain chains, the Cauca River also later flows into the Magdalena River in the Caribbean plains.

This mountainous region has a volcanic heritage. Some are still active today. This natural condition brings about ideal soils for the cultivation of high-quality coffees.

Altitudes range between 1,300 and 1,900 meters above sea level. Due to the geographical location near the equator, there is only little distinction between the different seasons in Colombia.

The varying altitudes and microclimates generated by the rivers and mountain ranges split the state so that the harvest takes place several times per year compared to other coffee producing countries: April- June main crop, October- January fly crop.
