## TANZANIA AB PLUS WASHED EDELWEISS ESTATE, RFA

Founded by German settlers around 1900, taken over by British administration after World War II and bought by Mr. BN Vohora in 1969, Edelweiss Estate is now run by a third generation coffee family business. Located at the edge of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area and surrounded by indigenous forests it stretches from 1,650 - 1,820 meters above sea level. Natural forest canopy shades the coffee trees.

The trees flower between November and February, harvest starts in early July. At their own wet mill the cherries are immediately pulped and fermented for up to 36 hours, then washed and dried on African beds under shadow and in full sun for about 8 to 10 days. The parchment is then transported to Arusha dry mill.

As the farm is located in a very remote region in Northern Tanzania, the Vohora family aims to engage with the whole surrounding community. They run various sustainability projects to support the local community and protect the natural environment. They provide apprenticeships at the farm, support local schools and founded nurseries for their employees' children. The farm shares a green border with the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. As a result elephants and buffalos cross the coffee plantation on a regular basis, challenging the farm and its delicate trees.
